Sub: Request for additional suggestions for the Union Budget of 2024-25

Dear Member exporters,

The full budget for 2024-25 is likely to be presented before Parliament in July 2024. In this regard, AEPC has received a communication from the Department of Commerce asking for suggestions and views for the Budget in prescribed Proforma (<u>Click to View</u>).

The DoC has already compiled suggestions received from EPCs for the interim budget and now seeks additional proposals. To enable us to send considered additional suggestions to the DoC, you are requested to kindly send us your inputs in the prescribed Proforma on most urgent basis. The Department has requested that while sending budget proposals, following should be taken note of:

- The pre-budget proposals should be complete in all respects, properly categorized and HS Codes, wherever applicable, for each commodity must be provided.
- Justification given in favour of the proposal be restricted to 300 words and Annexures should be used, if necessary.
- Members may categorise proposals as 'Top Priority', 'Priority' and 'Common Proposals'.
- Issues discussed year after year but never agreed to, may not be raised again.
