Dear Members,

AEPC among its various activities of Export Promotion also shares updates received from various Embassies of India for information and facilitation of our member exporters.

In this regard, we would like to inform that the Government of Egypt, through its Egyptian Customs Authorities, has made mandatory Advance Cargo Information (ACI) declarations with its new Egyptian Customs Decree 38 for all cargo inbound to Egypt starting <u>1 July 2021</u>. The process is managed through the National Single Window for Foreign Trade platform (NAFEZA), built by Misr Technology Systems (MTS). Key details of the decree are attached.

The Mission reached out to the Egyptian Customs to have an understanding of the system and were informed that the Egyptian importer should register all needed documents of the shipment on the following portal www.nafeza.gov.eg/en. The importer will then receive a shipment number which will be communicated to the Indian exporter to mention it in their shipping documents. The importer will then clear the shipment using that number and other shipping documents with the customs authorities. In case of any queries, the importer may get in touch with the below company who is authorized by the Egyptian Customs Authority to run the Single Window System:
